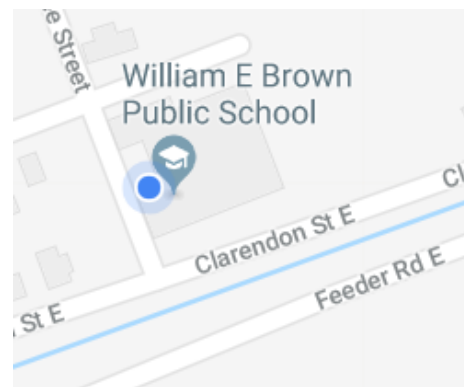
## Pick Up and Drop Off Routines

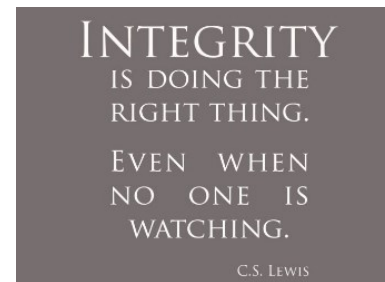
